STAMBAU TO NICHOLSON.

THE GRANTOR, Flora Stambau (a single woman, for and in consideration of One and no/100 (\$1.00) and other valuable consideration ~~in hand paid~~ convey's and warrants to Noemah Nicholson, my daughter, the following described real estate, situated in the County of Skamania; State of Washington. Beginning at a point twenty one and 2/3 (21.2/3) rods east of the northwest corner of section twenty eight (28) Township three (3) North of Range eight east of the Willamette Meridian; running thence south twenty four (24) rods; thence east thirteen and 1/3 (13.1/3) rods; thence north twenty four (24) rods; thence west thirteen and 1/3 (13.1/3) rods to point of beginning, containig two(2) acres. Beginning at a point fifty five (55) rods north of the southwest corner of the northeast 1/4 of the southeast 1/4 of Sec. twenty (20) in Township three (3) North of Range Eight (8) East of the Willamette Meridian, running thence east two hundred ten (210) feet; thence south one hundred four (104) feet; thence west two hundred ten (210) feet; and thence north one hundred four (104) feet to place of beginning containing one half (1/2) acres more or less. Beginning at a point four hundred twelve (412) feet east and thirty (30) feet north of the southwest corner of the southeast quarter of the southeast quarter of section twenty (20) Township three (3) North of Range Eight (8) East of the Willamette Meridian; running thence north one hundred (100) feet; thence east fifty (50) feet to the point of beginning.

The conditions of this deed are as follows; As a further consideration the Grantee agrees to give the Grantor a home with her as long as the said Grantor may live, and to provide medical aid, food, clothing and kind treatment and decent burial to the best of her means and ability.

It is also agreed that the grantor shall retain all interest in and to the above described property during her natural life time, and upon her death said property shall become the sole property of the grantee without further proceedings of any nature.
