KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, THAT Margaret St. Martin, a widow, for herself and also as Administratrix of the St. Martin Estate, in consideration of the sum of \$425.00 paid by Skamania County, State of Washington, and for the further consideration of said County agreeing to fence both sides of the right of way hereby conveyed, over and across lot #3 of Section 27, and to fence about $\frac{1}{4}$ of a mile more or less of said right of way across SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 21, using for said fence three barb wires with posts set one rod apart, and the County to build a connecting road for the grantor to intersect with said road State Road #8 at the most feasible and practical point and County agreeing to build underground cattle crossing and saving to said grantor all good timber on said right of way herein described, the said grantor does by these presents, grant, bargain, sell and convey and forever relinquish to said Skamania County, Washington a right of way as the same is now located and staked out over and across said lot #3 of Sec., 27 and the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 21 in Township 3 North of Range 8 East of Willamette Meridian.
