Hanchett, of said city, of the second part, WITNESSETH, That the said party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Three Thousand, Five Hundred Dollars, to him in hand paid by the said party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby confessed and acknowledged, does by these presents, grant, bargain, sell, remise, release, alien and confirm unto the party of the second part, and his heirs and assigns, FOREVER, all \_\_\_\_\_ certain piece or parcel of land, situate and being in the \_\_\_\_\_ of County of Skamania and State of Washington, known and described as follows, to-wit: All that portion of the East Half of the Southeast Quarter of Section Thirty (30), and the West Half of the Southwest Quarter of Section Twenty nine (29), in Township three (3) North, Range Eight (8) East of W.M. that lies north of the present County road going through said described land, containing 130 acres, more or less. Together with all and singular the hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining: To Have and to Hold the said premises as herein described, with the appurtenances unto the said party of the second part, and to his heirs and assigns, FOREVER, And the said Leavitt S. Griswold party of the first part, for himself, his heirs, executors, and administrators, does covenant, grant, bargain and agree, to and with the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns, that at the time of the ensealing and delivery of these presents he is well seized of the above granted premises in fee simple; that they are free from all encumbrances whatever; and that he will, and his heirs, executors and administrators forever shall Warrant and Defend the same against all lawful claims whatsoever.
