TILLY AND SMITH TO WENDORF.

THIS INDENTURE, Made this 29th day of July A.D. 1915, BETWEEN Frederick G. Tilly and Agness E. Tilly, his wife of Skamania County, Washington, and Frederick A. Smith and Gertrude J. Smith, his wife, of Hoquiam, Washington, the parties of the first part, and Helen L. Wendorf and W.A. Wendorf, her husband of Skamania County, Washington, the parties of the second part:

WITNESSETH, That the said parties of the first part, for Ten Dollars and other valuable consideration, to them in hand paid by the said parties of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents, remise, release and forever quit-claim unto the said parties of the second part, and to their heirs and assigns, the following described tract or parcel of land, situated, lying and being in the County of Skamania State of Washington, particularly bounded and described as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at the quarter corner on the east line of Section 16, Township 3, North, Range 10 East of the Willamette Meridian; thence West on the quarter line for 56 rods; Thence North 40 rods; thence west 64 rods; thence south 40 rods; thence east 40 rods; thence south 80 rods; thence east 45 rods; thence north 48 rods; thence east 35 rods to the east line of said section 16; thence north along said line for 32 rods to the point of beginning; said tract containing 45½ acres, more or less, all lines and directions being in accordance with the government survey of said land, together with the tenements hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging, or in anywise appertaining and particularly a one half interest in and to a certain water right filed by W.A. Wendorf on May 19, 1905 on the of the NE¼ of the NE¼ of Section 16, Township 3, North, Range 10 East of the Willamette-Meridian for irrigating and domestic purposes to be diverted by flume, ditch or pipe and all pipes ditches or flumes or other means used for diverting said water, and all our rights in and to said water right.
