THIS INDENTURE MADE this 18th day of December, 1915 BETWEEN W. A. Wendorf husband of Helen L. Wendorf, of Skamania County, State of Washington, the party of the first part and Helen L. Wnedorf his wife, the party of the second part:

WITNESSETH, That the said party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Ten Dollars, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, and in consideration of love and affedtion, does by these presents remise, release and forever quit-claim unto the said party of the second part, and to her heirs and assigns, the following described tracts of land, situated, lying and being in the County of Skamania, State of Washington, particularly bounded and described as follows, to-wit:
