#### GRIFFITH TO CORLIE.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That Gaylord C. Griffith and Florence C. Griffith his wife, of Underwood in the State of Washington being of lawful age, in consideration of One Dollar and other valuable considerations, to them paid by Glenn C. Corlie of Underwood in the State of Washington do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto said Glenn C. Corlie his heirs and assigns, all the following bounded and described real property situated in the county of Skamania and State of Washington.

All that certain tract of land commencing at a point 1852 feet easterly from a point in the west line of Section Nineteen, Township Three North of Range Ten East of Willamette Meridian 834 feet south of the Northwest corner of said Section Nineteen, said point of commencement being the Northeast corner of a tract conveyed by George S. Whiteside and wife and Hugh W. Hamlin and wife to the said Glenn C. Corlie in a deed recorded June tenth 1910 in Book "M" of deeds at page 310 in the Records of Skamania County, Washington; running thence east fifty feet to a point; thence south five hundred feet to a point in the southernmost line of the tract designated as the Homes Tract in said deed to Corlie; thence westerly along said line, which is a continuation of the south line of said Corlie tract fifty feet to a point which is the southeast corner of said Corlie tract; thence north along the east line of said Corlie tract five hundred feet to the place of beginning; containing fifty seven hundredths of an acre, more or less.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, the above granted premises with all the rights, easements and appurtenances thereto belonging unto the said Glenn C. Corlie, his heirs and assigns forever. And the said grantors do covenant to and with the said grantee his heirs and assigns that they are lawfully seized in fee of the above granted premises; that they are free from all encumbrances, and that they will and their heirs, executors and administrators shall warrant and defend the above granted premises, to the said grantee his heirs and assigns forever against the lawful claims and demands of all persons.
