Sandeli, husband and wife, parties of the first part, for their heirs, executors, and administrators do covenant with the said party of the second part, its heirs and assigns, that they well seized in fee of the lands and premises afcresaid, and have good right to sell and convey the same in the manner and form aforesaid; that the same are free from all encumbrances and the tabove bargained and granted lands and premises, in the quiet and peaceful possession of the said party of the second part, its heirs and assigns, against all persons lawfully claiming or to claim the whole or any part thereof, the said parties of the first part have hereunto set their hands and seals the day and year first above written.
