Now, Therefore, the said party of the first part, pussuant to the order last aforesaid, and for and in consideration of the sum of Fourteen hundred dollars, (\$1400.00) to her in hand paid by the party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and conveyed, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and convey, unto thesaid party of the second part, his heirs and assigns the undivided one-third interest belonging to the said Cark Kuffler, manor, in and to the merchantable timber located, standing and being on the land described as being the West half (\$\frac{1}{4}\$) of the West half (\$\frac{1}{4}\$) of Section Twenty-three (23), Township Two (2) North of Range Six (6) East of the Willamette Meridian, in Skamania County, State of Washington, excepting therefrom a strip along the West side thereof containing two and one half (\$\frac{1}{4}\$) acres, in each forty acre tract thereof. It being agreed by the parties hereto that second party is to have and he is hereby granted two and one half (\$\frac{1}{4}\$) years in which to remove said timber, and he is hereby granted, as far as the interest of said minor is concerned the necessary right-of-ways, during said time, over and across said land.
