THIS INDENTURE, Made and entered into this 28th day of March, 1916, by and between The Stevenson Water Company, a corporation duly organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Washington, with place of business at Stevenson in said State, party of the first part, hereinafter called the Company, and Bank of Stevenson, a banking corporation duly organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Washington, with place of business at Stevenson in said State, party of the second part, hereinafter called the Trustee, WITNESSETH:

That whereas the Company is duly organized and incorporated under the laws of the State of Washington, and under its articles of incorporation is granted authority to issue bonds and secure the same by mortgage of the franchise rights, contracts and property of the Company.

And whereas pursuant to the power and authority possessed by it, the Company has determined to issue its bonds to the amount of Ten Thousand (\$10,000) Dollars, in the form, amounts, maturities and bearing the interest hereinafter stated; and to execute and deliver this Indenture for the purpose of securing the same;
