

GRAY TO ADAMS.

THIS INDENTURE, Made the 27th day of July, in the year of our lord one thousand nine hundred and sixteen between William L. Gray and Clara Gray his wife the parties of the first part and Netta Adams the party of the second part, WITNESSETH, That the said parties of the first part for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar lawful money of the United States of America, to them in hand paid by the said party of the second part the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents remise, release, convey and forever quit claim unto the said party of the second part and to her heirs and assigns all those certain parcels of land situated in the County of Skamania State of Washington, and bounded and particularly described as follows, to-wit: All interest of the said parties of the first part of in and to the following described real property situated in Skamania County, Washington, to-wit: The west forty acres of Lots six and seven in Section thirty six, Tp. 3 N.R. 7 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. of W.M., The said land being bounded as follows: The east line of said land being a line parallel to the west line of said lots six and seven, the north line coinciding with the north boundary of said lot six, the west line being the west boundary of said lots six and seven, the south line coinciding with the north line of the Henry Shepard Donation Land Claim. This deed is given to correct certain errors in the description of a certain deed given by William L. Gray and Clara Gray his wife to said Netta Adams dated Jan. 7, 1910 and recorded Jan. 17, 1910 in Book M of Deeds p. 149 records of Skamania Co. Wash. and for the correction of another deed given by said grantors to said grantee, given Dec. 21, 1910, recorded Dec. 21, 1910. in Book N of Deeds, p. 17 records of said Skamania Co. Wash. together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging, or in anywise appertaining, and the reversion and reversions, remainder and remainders, rents, issues and profits thereof.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, All and singular, the said premises, together with the appurtenances, unto said part of the second part, and to heirs and assigns forever.
