Greene, of Stevenson, County of Skamania, State of Washington, the party of the second part, has GRANTED, BARGAINED AND SOLD, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said party of the second part, and to his heirs and assigns, the following described <sup>real</sup> property situate, lying and being in the County of Skamania State of Washington, to-wit: Beginning at a point fifteen and four tenths (15.4) feet west of the quarter post on the south side of section thirty six (36) Township three (3) North of Range seven (7) East of the Willamette Meridian; thence west two hundred and seventy four and three tenths (274.3) feet thence north five degrees and thirty minutes (5 deg. 30') west four hundred and sixty five and four tenths (465.4) feet; thence south seventy four degrees (74 deg.) east two hundred and forty one (241) feet; thence south eleven degrees nineteen minutes (11 deg. 9') east to the point of beginning, containing three (3) acres, more or less.
