

LONG TO LONG.

THIS INDENTURE, Made this 3rd day of August, in the year of our Lord One Thousand Nine Hundred and sixteen BETWEEN B.E.Long of Skamania Washington, the party of the first part, and Stella R.Long, his wife, of same place, the party of the second part:

WITNESSETH, That the said party of the first part, for and in consideration of love and affection and of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) of the United States of America to him in hand paid by the said party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, by the party of the first part, does by these presents, ^{remise} /release and forever quit claim unto the said party of the second part her heirs and assigns, the following described tract, lot or parcel of land, situated, lying and being in the County of Skamania State of Washington, particularly bounded and described as follows, to-wit: "Commencing at a point on the south side of Cape Horn, road 406 feet east and 2010 feet south of the northeast corner of Lot numbered two in section one, township one north of range four east of the Willamette Meridian, which point is also the northwest corner of the southwest quarter of section six, township one north of range five east of the Willamette Meridian, running thence in an Easterly direction along the south side of said Cape Horn, County Road, about 902 feet to where same intersects the Marris Didier private road, which road joins on the West a 127/8 acre tract heretofore on April 17th, 1905 conveyed by H.P. Davis, and wife to Joseph H.Didier and recorded in Book "I" of Deeds on page 149, thence southwesterly, along the said Didier West line and private road, 36 rods more or less, to the south boundary line of Section six (6) thence west along said south boundary line to the southwest corner of said section six (6) thence north along the west boundary line of said section six (6) to the south side of said Cape Horn County Road, thence easterly, along the south side of said Cape Horn County Road to the point of commencement. Together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining, and the reversion and reversions, remainder and remainders, rents, issues and profits thereof.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the said premises, together with the appurtenances, unto said party of the second part, and to her heirs and assigns forever.
