THIS DEED, Made the first day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and sixteen, by the NORTHERN PACIFIC RAILWAY COMPANY, a corporation of the State of Wisconsin, grantor, to Charles W. Mead of Portland, in the County of Multnomah and State of Oregon, grantee, WITNESSETH:

The grantor, in consideration of the sum of three hundred thirty (\$330.00) Dollars, unto it paid, the receipt whereof is acknowledged, remises, releases and quitclaims unto the grantee, his heirs and assigns, all its right, title and interest in and to the following described tract of land, situate in the County of Skamania, and State of Washington, to-wit:

The northeast quarter of southeast quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of section six (6) in township two (2) north of range seven (7) east of the Willamette Principle Meridian, containing, according to the United States Government Survey, forty (40.00) acres, more or less; Subject, as reserved in the patent from the United States, to a right of way thereon for ditches or canals constructed by the authority of the United States.
