TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, The siad premises and appurtenances thereunto belonging unto the saud part of the second part their heirs and assigns forever, as fully and absolutely as the said party of the first part, can, may or ought to, by virtue of the said sale unders said special execution and order of confirmation and the statute in such cases made and provided, grant, bargain, sell, conv ey and confirm the same.
