Witnesseth: That the said party of the first part, for and in consideration of One Dollar, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, does by these presents remise, release convey and forever quitclaim unto said parties of the second part, and to their heirs and assigns all that certain lot, place or parcel of land situated in the County of Skamania, State of Washington, and bounded and particularly described as follows, to-wit:

The East One-half ( $E \frac{1}{2}$ ) of the Southeast Quarter ( $SE \frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section Twenty-seven (27) in Township Three (3), North of Range Nine (9), E.W. M.

Together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging, or any wise appertaining, and the reversion and reversions, remainder and remainders, rents, issues and profits thereof.

To have and to Hold, All and singular, the said premises, together with the appurtenances unto the parties of the second part, and their heirs and assigns forever.
