DECLARATION OF HOMESTEAD.

THIS IS TO CERTIFY that the undersigned, CLARENCE D. WALKER, makes this declaration of homestead as follows:

That his family consists of himself, his wife, and two children, one twelve years old and one six years old, both girls, and that he is the head of the family the two girls residing with him at the present time and his wife is away working. ^{and his two daughters}

That the homestead consists of a dwelling house in which the claimant resides and the land on which same is situated is described as follows, to-wit:-
Beginning at a point 10 chains South of the N.E. Corner of lot 3 of Sec. 36, T³ N. R. 7. E.W.M. running thence south 6 $\frac{1}{4}$ chains thence west 15.75 thence north 6 $\frac{1}{4}$ chains, and thence East 15.75 to place of beginning containing 10 acres more or less.

That the value of the land claimed as a homestead does not exceed the sum of \$2000.00 and that the property desired for a homestead and as above described was the community property of himself and wife and he now makes this declaration of homestead in accordance with the provisions of the homestead laws of Washington and selects the real estate and premises above described as a homestead for himself and family.
