This Indenture, Made this 2nd day of June 1916, between L.H. Boutell, a bachelor, the party of the first part, and J.M. Jessup, a bachelor, party of the second part,

WITNESSETH: That the party of the first part, for and in the consideration of the sum of Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, does by these presents remise, release, convey and forever quit claim unto said party of the second part, and unto his heirs and assigns all that certain lot, piece or parcel of land situated in the County of Skamania, State of Washington, and bounded and particularly described as follows, to-wit:

Lot one (1), block five (5) of the Manzanola Orchard and Land Company Tract as platged and filed with the County Auditor of said Skamania County, State of Washington, of which said lot is a part and which said land described in said plat is otherwise known and described as the north-east quarter of the south-east quarter of the northeast quarter of section ten, township three, north of range nine, east of Willamette meridian, containing ten acres, more or less.

Together with all and singular tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging, or anywise appertaining, and the reversion and reversions, remainder and remainders rents, issues and profits thereof.

To Have And Hold, All and singular, the said premises, together with appurtenances, unto the party of the second part, and to his heirs and assigns forever.
