POWER OF ATTORNEY TO CONVEY LIEU LANDS.

Santa Fe Pacific R.R. Co. - Clark W. Thompson.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That Whereas, the Santa Fe Pacific Railroad Company, a corporation duly incorporated under an Act of Congress approved March 3, 1897, has relinquished to the United States of America under the Act of June 4th 1897 and June 6th 1900 the following described lands located within the San Francisco Mountains Forest Reserve Territory of Arizona, to-wit: Lot numbered five of Section one Township nineteen North Range six East of the Gila and Salt River Base Meridian, Arizona, containing forty acres more or less, and Whereas the Santa Fe Pacific Railroad Company is entitled to select in lieu therefor a like quantity of vacant surveyed non-mineral public lands of the United States which are subject Moestead entry; Now Therefore, the Santa Fee Pacific Railroad Company has made, constituted and appointed Clark W. Thompson its true and lawful agent, for it, and in its name place and stead to convey by quit-claim deed all the right title and interest and claim which said Santa Fe Pacific Railroad Company has or may hereafter acquire in the lands so selected or located by said Santa Fe Pacific Railroad Company, or its dully appointed attorney in fact in lieu of the lands so relinquished, as such selections shall have been actually made at the United States District land office and which shall appear described upon the public records in the office of the commissioner of Public Lands Washington, D.C. as the lieu lands so selected. Giving and granting unto the said attorney full power and authority to do and perform all and every act and thing whatsoever necessary to be done in the above premises as fully to all intents and purposes as it might or could do if personally present, hereby ratifying and confirming all that its said attorney shall lawfully do or cause to be done by virtue of these presents. And the said Santa Fe Pacific Railroad Company to any grantee in conveyance executed by said attorney hereby gives notice that said attorney hereunder has authority to convey in whole or in part only the lands actually selected in lieu of the premises hereinbefore specified, and the premises so conveyed by said attorney as such lieu lands, shall render any conveyance of the latter hereunder void.
