The grantors, William Thurston, Sr. and Philomina Thurston, his wife, residing at Carson, Washington, in consideration of Twelve Hundred Dollars in hand paid by Wind River Lumber Company, a corporation, of Wisconsin, convey and warrant to Wind River Lumber Company, a corporation, the following described real estate situate in Skamania County, Washington: Lot two, being the Southwest quarter of the Northwest quarter of Section seven, containing thirty eight and twelve hundredths acres more or less and the South ten and ninety four hundredths acres of Lot one, being the northwest quarter of the northwest quarter of section seven and the west ten and ninety four hundredths acres of the southeast quarter of the northwest quarter of section seven; all according to the United States Government Survey in township three north or range eight east of the Willamette meridian and containing in all sixty acres;

Together with the right and privilege of impounding the waters of Wind River and releasing the same in artificial freshets for the purpose of driving logs and other timber products down said stream and also the right to build and maintain a dam or dams on Wind River and the right to overflow lands adjacent to said conveyed premises to such height and extent as may be caused by the location and maintenance of a dam or dams in said Wind River or its tributaries for any purpose.
