Washington, with the north line of Section 1 in Twp. 2 North of Range 7 East of W.M., thence north 50° West 470 feet, thence south 960 feet, thence east 200 feet, thence north 52° and 12' East 150 feet, thence west 180 feet, thence north 16 feet, thence east 175 feet, thence north 52° and 12' east and 85 feet, thence north 518 feet to the place of beginning, containing 6.75 acres, more or less.
