debtedness being so paid and a surplus fund arising, the surplus fund shall be paid into the registry of the court for further order and distribution thereof.

In the event of disqualification or inability to act of the Master in Chancery hereinbefore designated the Court upon application therefor will make another appointment of Masser Commissioner, and the power to so appoint insuch case is hereby reserved. Any personal property in the hands of the Receiver of the Oregon-Washington Timber Company shall be delivered over by the Receiver to the purchaser of the properties of the said company, and any personal property belonging to the Washington Northern Railroad Company over by the receiver shall be delivered/to the purchaser of the properties of the Washington Northern Railroad Company.

The purchaser at any sale hereunder being entitled to a bill of sale hereunders retitled to tax to the sale, deed or deeds for the propertied purchased at the sale, the Receiver of the court shall execute and deliver likewise a bill of, sale, dded, or deeds to the purchaser of the property so purchased, and the complainants herein, Mississippi Valley Trust Company, Trustee pand Union Trust Company, Trustee, and the defendants herein, Washington Northern Railroad Company, and Oregon-Washington Timber Company, shall unite in any and all bills of sale, deed, or deeds to which such purchaser is entitled and in the event of the failbre of either of the said parties to unite in such deeds or bill of or separately to execute such deeds or bill of sale, this decree shall stand as and for the bibl of sale, deed, or deeds required by the decree to be executed by the said parties.

Either party to this cause may apply at the foot of the decree for such further order in the premises as may not have been adjudicated by this decree. Let this cause be adjourned over accordingly and let a certified copy of this decree issue as and for process of enforcement thereof.
