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ROBERT L. FOWLER et ux to E.J. MILLER

THIS INDENTURE, Made this 6th day of June A.D. 1917 between Robert L. Fowler and Mildred Fowler, husband and wife parties of the first part, and E.J. Miller party, of the second part, WITNESSETH, That the said parties of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar and other valuable considerations to them in hand paid by the said party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey, unto the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns forever, the following described property lying and being in the County of Skamania and State of Washington, and described as follows, to-wit:

All of our right, title and interest in and to that certain water-right secured by filing notice June 17, 1908, said notice being recorded in Book E of Miscellaneous at page 290, records of Skamania County, Wash., and was worded as follows: "The undersigned claims the water flowing in this stream to the extent of one cubic foot of water per second of time. I claim the water for domestic purposes and irrigation and I intend to use it at N $\frac{1}{2}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 14, Tp. 3 N. R. 9 E of W.M. I intend to divert the water at a point 465 feet West and 629 feet North of the SW corner of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 14 Tp. 3 N. R. 9 E. W.M. by means of ditch or flume. Notice posted June 9, 1908. Robert L. Fowler, Claimant".

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME, Together with all the hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging, or in anywise appertaining, to the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns forever. And the said parties of the first part, for their heirs, executors and administrators, do covenant with the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns, that they well seized in fee of the lands and premises aforesaid, and have a good right to sell and convey the same in manner and form aforesaid; that the same are free from all encumbrances. And the above bargained and granted lands and premises, in the quiet and peaceful possession of the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns, against all persons lawfully claiming, or to claim, the whole or any part thereof, the said parties of the first part will warrant and defend.
