

THOMPSON TO DEL GROSSO

ASSIGNMENT OF CONTRACT.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS THAT, I, Albert Thompson, in consideration of the sum of \$125.00 to me paid by Ben Del Grosso and Annie Del Grosso, husband and wife, of Cape Horn, Skamania County, Washington, do hereby sell, set over, transfer and assign to said Ben Del Grosso and Annie Del Grosso, their heirs and assigns, a certain contract entered into between Bartholemew Bennett, of Cape Horn, Washington, and Froeschle Bros., on the 27th day of February, 1911, which contract was on the 2nd day of October, 1911 assigned and transferred by the said Froeschle Bros. to Mary Froeschle, and thereafter and on the 5th day of May, 1915, the said Mary Froeschle assigned the same to Albert Thompson.

Said contract conveys the following described property, to-wit:

Commencing at the center of Section three (3), township One (1), North of Range five (5) east of the Willamette Meridian at a stone set below the surface in the center of the County road, thence along the east line of the Southwest 1/4 of section Three 8.49 chains to the northeast corner of the school lot, thence south 80°--44' west along the northline of the school lot 6.78 chains, thence north 1°--46' east 9.30 chains to the center of the County road, thence along the center of the County road 87°--46' east .45 chains to the place of beginning, containing six (6) acres more or less. Which contract was recorded in Book of Deeds "N" on page 97 on the 17th day of March, 1911, in the Deed records of Skamania County, Washington.
