

matter or thing arising hereunder, to make such other and further orders as may reasonably be required to enforce the terms, provisions and conditions of this decree, to protect the property of the said Railway Company required by it for public use, and to require the construction and use of such highway in such manner as may be required to avoid danger to the operation of trains upon said railway, and the Court hereby expressly reserves the power hereunder to close said highway to travel, if necessary, for the enforcement of the terms and conditions hereof, or for the enforcement of orders hereafter entered for the purpose above mentioned.
