

OLENE to ATTWELL.

THIS INDENTURE, Made this 2nd day of May, A.D. 1918, between Charles Olin and Hilda Olin, his wife, the parties of the first part and J.F. Attwell, and J.F. Attwell as guardian for James F. Attwell/and Alice Attwell and Albert Attwell, minors, the parties of the second part;

WITNESSETH, That the said parties of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar and other valuable considerations of the United States of America, to them in hand paid by the said parties of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged do by these presents, remise, release and forever quitclaim unto the said parties of the second part, and to their heirs, assigns, all their right, title and interest in and to the following described tract, lot, or parcel of land, situated, lying and being in the County of Skamania, State of Washington, particularly bounded and described as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at station 5 02 on state highway No. 8. on a line to common to sections 1 and 2, township 2 North of Range 2 East W.M., said point of beginning being 2064.7 feet south of the township line; thence south 37° 31' West 302.5 feet; thence south 4° 6' West 142.6 feet; thence south 59° 47' East 224.2 feet to a station on state highway No. 8. known as 9 98, thence north along the section line between sections 1 and 2, 496 feet to the point of beginning containing 1.45 acres in Skamania County, Wash. Together with all and singular, the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining, and the reversion and reversions, remainder and remainders, rents, issues and profits thereof.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, and and singular the said premises, together with the appurtenances, ~~and the reversions~~ unto the said parties of the second part and to their heirs and assigns forever.
