WITNESSETH: that the seller, in consideration of the sum of One Dollar to him in hand paid by the buyer, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, hath agreed and hereby doth agree to assign to the buyer, by a good and sufficient assignment in writing, on or before the First day of July, 1920, all that certain bond or obligation, bearing date the 6th day of November, 1911, and recorded on November 19th, 1912, in the Office of the County Auditor of the County of Skamania in the State of Washington, in Book C of seeds at Page 133, in which bond the seller is named as the Obligee, acopy of said bond is hereto attached, marked "EXHIBIT A".
