"Beginning at the Southwest corner of the Northeast quarter of the Northeast quarter of Section 20, Township 3 North of Range 8 East of the Willamette Meridian, thence South 65 Rods to the Northwest corner of the land herein described; thence East 80 Rods; thence South 20 Rods; thence West 80 Rods; thence North 20 Rods to place of beginning, containing ten (10) acres."

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, the said premises, with all their appurtenances, into the said party of the second part and to his heirs and assigns forever.
