THOMAS MONAGHAN et ux to SKAMANIA COUNTY

THIS INDENTURE made this 26th day of May 1919, between Thomas Monaghan, and Annie F. Monaghan, his wife, parties of the first part, and Skamania County, Washington, party of the second part, witnesseth;

for County
 That whereas, the said party of the second part is desirous of procuring more land for a right of way along State Road #8, now "The North Bank Highway" through the land of the said parties of the first part in said Skamania County, the said additional right of way to be One Hundred feet in width adjoining and along the Southerly side of the present right of way through said land, and to begin just above what is known as the "Monaghan Gravel Pit" and thence run in a Southeasterly direction about a quarter of a mile to the East line of the land of said first parties;

Now, therefore, in consideration of the sum of Four Hundred and no/100 Dollars (\$400.00) to them in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, and of the covenants hereinafter provided to be performed by the said party of the second part, the said parties of the first part do hereby RELEASE, REMISE, CONVEY and QUIT-CLAIM unto the said party of the second part, its successors and assigns, the above mentioned strip of land, more particularly bounded and described as follows; to-wit:

Commencing at a point 50 feet right angle to Station 288+24.9, point of tangent on Stevenson-Collins section of State Road #8, now "North Bank Highway", thence in a straight line to a point 150 feet distant from said station; thence following the center line of said road in a Southeasterly direction, parallel to
