Northeast quarter (SW¹/₄ of NE¹/₄); Northwest quarter of Southeast quarter (NW¹/₄ of SE¹/₄); Northeast quarter of Southwest quarter (NE¹/₄ of SW¹/₄), Section Seventeen (17), Township Seven (7) North of Range Five (5) East; thence through the Northeast quarter (NE¹/₄) Section Thirty-one (31), Township Eight (8) North of Range Five (5) East, and Lots One (1), Two (2), Three (3) and Four (4), Section Nineteen (19); Lots One (1) and Two (2), Section Thirty-one (31), South half of North half (S¹/₂ of N¹/₂), Section Seventeen (17), Township Nine (9) North of Range Five (5) East, W.M.

Following the Mt. St. Helens Wagon Road across the East half of East Half (Eg of Eg) Section Twenty-seven (27), Township Nine (9) North of Range Five (5) East, W. M.

Along the Spirit Lake-Guler Trail, across Lots One (1), Two (2), Three (3) in Section Thirteen (13), Township Nine (9) North of Range Five (5) East, W. M., and Lot One (1) and Southeast quarter of Northeast quarter (SE of NE) of Section Five (5), Township Nine (9) North of Range Six (6) East, W. M. and to be used for the purpose of communication by telephone and telegraph and none other.

Should at any time in the future the grantor, its successors and assigns desire to remove the timber standing upon the within described tract of land the grantee will, at its own expense, maintain or reconstruct the line in such a manner or upon such a location that logging operations will not be interfered with.

This grant shall be effective as long as said easement shall be actually used for the purpose above specified and all rights hereunder shall revert to the owner of the land as soon as the said use thereof shall be abandoned and discontinued.

The grantee shall at all reasonable times have the right to enter for the purpose of construction, repairing, patrolling and removing such telephone and telegraph lines, doing as little damage as possible.
