corner of Township Two (2) North of Range Seven(7) East of the Willamette Meridian; thence along said meander line in front of said Section Six (6), in Township Two (2) North of Range Seven and one half (72) East of the Willamette Meridian, as follows: South Thirty (30) degrees West Eleven and Fifty hundredths (11.50) Chains; South Sixty-eight (68) degrees Thirty (30) minutes West Six (6) chains to meander corner on Range line between Ranges Seven (7) and Seven and one half  $(7\frac{1}{2})$ East, which is Twelve and Sixty-two hundredths (12.62) chains/from the Northeast corner of Township Two (2) North of Range Seven (7) East of the Willamette Meridian, having a total frontage measured along said meander line in front of Section Six (6), said Township Two (2) North, Range Seven and one half (7) East of the Willamette Meridian, of Seventeen and Fifty hundredths (17.50) chains; together with all riparian and shore rights and privileges adjacent and appurtenant thereto, and accretions, if any. That certain tract of real property situated in the County of Skamania, State of Washington, and bounded and described as follows, to-wit: Beginning at a point Twenty (20) chains East of corner of Sections Twenty-nine (29), Thirty (30) Thirty one (31) and Thirty two (32), in Township Three (3) North of Range Eight (8) East of the Willamette Meridian, on a true line; thence East on a true line Eight (8) chains and Fifty (50) links; thence South to the meander line of the Columbia River; thence in a Westerly direction with the meander line of the said Columbia River to a point directly South of said point of beginning; thence North to the place of beginning, the same being the Southeast corner of the Southwest quarter of the Southwest quarter of Section Twenty-nine (29), in Township Three (3) North of Range Eight (8) East of the Willamette Meridian; together with all riparian and shore rights and privileges adjacent and appurtenant thereto, and accretions, if any, The said land so particularly described is the same property conveyed by Columbia River and Northern Railway Company to The Dalles, Portland & Astoria Navigation Company by deed dated 28 May, 1915, recorded in Book "P", beginning at Page 358 of the deed records of said Skamania County, Washington.
- 4. That certain tract of real property situated in the City of The Dalles, County of Wasco, and State of Oregon, and bounded and described as follows, to-wit:

Commencing at a point on the North line of Main Street in the City of The Dalles, Twenty-nine (29) feet Easterly from the Southeast corner of Lot Six(6) in Block One (1), according to the original plat of Dalles City, Oregon; thence Easterly and along the North line of said street Thirty-two (32) feet; thence in a Northerly direction parallel with the East line of said lot Six (6), One hundred (100) feet; thence Westerly on a line parallel with the North line of said Main Street, Thirty-two (32) feet; thence Southerly One hundred (100) feet to the place of beginning, and being the sameland conveyed by William H. Waldron to The Dalles, Portland & Astoria Navigation Company by deed dated 27 December, 1895, recorded in Book "W", beginning at Page 40 of the deed records of said Wasco County.
