THIS INDENTURE WITNESSETH That Gustavus Johnson and Amelia Johnson, his wife for and in consideration of the sum of One Hundred Twenty-five Dollars, to them paid, have BARGAINED and SOLD, and by these presents do Bargain, Sell and Convey unto John Palmer the following described premises, to-wit:

Commencing at a point 542.2 feet South of a rock, marking the intersection of the line of the Shepard Donation Land Claim and the North line of Section One, Township Two North of Range 7 East of Will. Mer., said point being the intersection of the North line of State Road No. 8, 610 feet to the place of beginning of Gust. Johnson's land; thence North 100 feet, thence East 100 feet, thence North 10 feet to the place of beginning of the tract to be conveyed; thence North 100 feet, thence West 50 feet, thence South 100 feet, thence East 50 feet to place of beginning. In consideration of the payment made the 10 foot strip of land on the South of the tract above described and conveyed is hereby dedicated to the use of the public ^{for} for an alley or street.
