Johnson, and unto their heirs and assigns, all her rights, title and interest in and to all that parcel of real estate situate in County of Skamania, State of Washington, to-wit:

The undivided one-half of Section Twenty (20) Township Three (3) North, Range Five (5) East, Willamette Meridian, and in Ball Mountain Mining District, mining claims numbers Six Thousand Eight Hundred Three (6803) and Six Thousand Eight Hundred Twenty-four (6824) as appear from location of quartz mines of record in the Auditor's office of said County and State, in Book E, on Page 274, and Book E on Page 276, as appears from the description in the location dated April 24, 1919, and also an undivided one-half interest in a mill site containing Five (5) acres located on the same date, and described as 400 feet by 500 feet, for the purpose of working the Victory Load Mining Claims, and commencing at a post marked No. 1, 200 feet Northeast of the notice, thence 500 feet South to corner stake No. 2, thence 400 ft.
