

in writing, at its office, and in no event longer than Three (3) days after the happening of such contingency, and no action or off-set, or counter-claim shall be maintained by any consumer for such damage as said Company could have prevented if it had had such notice; nor unless claim in writing shall have been made in the office of said Company, at Home Valley, Washington, for such damages, specifying the amount and cause of the same by the 15th of the calander month next succeeding the month in which said damage occurred.

8. Said Home Valley Irrigation & Power Company shall have the option to install and own all conduits of every nature connecting the premises herein described with the laterals of said Company. No conduit connections of the premises herein described with the laterals of said Company shall be made, except either by or under the supervision of said Company.

9. Whenever the Consumer is in default under any obligation imposed upon him by the constitution or laws of the State of Washington, or by any regulation of said Home Valley Irrigation & Power Company now in force, or hereafter adopted, said Home Valley Irrigation & Power Company shall have the right to shut off the water from the premises of the consumer. The apparatus for shutting the water in said Company's conduits off from the premises herein described, and turning the same on the said premises shall be in the exclusive possession and control of said Company at all times.

10. Water for irrigation shall be delivered during such irrigation season each year, but the particular hours of the day in which the same shall be delivered shall be under the control exclusively of the said Home Valley Irrigation & Power Company. Water shall be measured at point of delivery on said Company's conduits.

11. The consumer must use economy and good husbandry at all times in the use of water, adopting any and all approved and reasonable expedients for the economical use of water. As soon, from time to time, as sufficient water has been used for any purpose herein authorized, the water shall be shut off by the consumer and kept shut off until needed. Consumer shall maintain a stopcock in his pipe, connecting with said Company's conduit, for shutting off the water by the Consumer, as aforesaid.

12. Water shall not be used for any purpose, either directly or indirectly, incidentally or otherwise, than for irrigation and domestic purposes on said premises.

13. Said Home Valley Irrigation & Power Company shall be under no obligations to any transferee of this water right or said premises until such transfer shall have been duly executed in writing and acknowledged in the manner for acknowledgements or conveyances of real property, and the same or an original duplicate thereof, shall have been filed with said Company nor shall such assignment or transfer take effect until this certificate shall have been returned to said Company and another certificate in duplicate in accordance with the rules and regulations of said Company at such time, shall have been issued and approved and accepted in writing, executed and acknowledged by the assignee and the husband or wife of assignee.
