CASCADE LAND & INVESTMENT CO. to GEO. F. CHRISTENSEN
WARRANTY DEED.

THIS INDENTURE, made this 22 day of July, 1918, between the Cascade Land & Investment Co., a corporation of the State of Washington, the party of the first part, and Geo. F. Christensen the party of the second part;

WITNESSETH, that the said party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Ten (\$10) Dollars and other valuable consideration, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, does hereby GRANT, BARGAIN, SELL and CONVEY unto the said party of the second part, his heirs, and assigns forever, all that certain tract of land situated in the County of Skamania and State of Washington and known and described as follows, to-wit:

Commencing at the Northwest corner of the B. B. Bishop D. L. C. 39 a stone 6X8X12 inches, marked C.39, bearing trees standing; thence South on West line of claim. At 1364 ft. the NE corner of the G. W. Johnson D.L.C. at 1860 ft. intersect, the North edge of Greenleaf Slough, set post; thence on above line at 1795 ft. set hub for initial point of survey, said hub being in center of State Road No.8; thence following State Road as follows:
