EDWIN M. STRUNK et ux to ARTHUR J. TURNBULL

THIS INDENTURE WITNESSETH, That Edwin M. Strunk and Anna M. Strunk, husband and wife, of the County of Clarke, State of Washington, parties of the first part, for and in consideration of One (\$1.00) Dollar and other valuable considerations, in hand paid by Arthur J. Turnbull, party of the second part, have Granted, Bargained and Sold, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said party of the second part, and to his heirs and assigns, the following described real estate situate in the County of Skamania, State of Washington, to-wit:

An undivided one-half of the Southwest quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Twenty-six (26) in Township Two (2) North of Range Five (5) East of the Willamette Meridian, containing one hundred and sixty (160) acres, more or less.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the said party of the second part, and to his heirs and assigns forever.

This deed is made for the purpose of correcting an error in a certain deed made by the parties of the first part to the party of the second part, dated March 13, 1911, recorded in Book "N" of Deeds of said Skamania County, Washington, at Page 95, in which said deed the grantee's name was erroneously written "Arthur J. Turnble" by mistake of the scrivener preparing said deed, and as thus erroneously written, said deed was executed and delivered by mutual mistake of the parties, said deed being intended to convey the title to Arthur J. Turnbull. In the recording of said deed, an additional error was made by writing the grantee's name "Arthur J. Trimble".

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the parties of the first part have hereunto set their hands and seals this 3rd day of February, 1919.
