Commencing at a point on the East side of Strawberry Road, 180 feet North of the S.W. Cor. of Lot No. 10 in Stevenson Park, in Sec. 36, in Township 3 N. R. 7 E. W.M.; thence S. 60 ft.; thence E. 123 ft., more or less, to the West side-line of a 40 ft. road following an old skid road; thence North-westerly along the West side of said ~~40~~ 40-foot road to a point East of the point of the point of beginning; thence W. 79 ft., more or less, to the point of beginning.
