TO CORRECT THIS ERROR I NOW STATE THAT THE PERSONS SIGNING SAID QUIT CLAIM DEED DATED APRIL 17TH, 1895, RECORDED MAY 26TH, 1896, IN BOOK "E" OF DEEDS AT PAGE 299 SCAMANIA COUNTY, WASHINGTON, WERE ALL AND THE ONLY HEIRS OF WILLIAM HAFHEY, DECEASED, THAT THERE WERE NO MINOR HEIRS, THAT IT WAS OUR INTENTION TO GIVE CORNELIUS HAFHEY, GRANTEE IN THE SAID DEED, A DEED CONVEYING TO HIM ALL OR RIGHT, TITLE AND INTEREST IN AND TO THE LAND DESCRIBED THEREIN, AS ALL AND THE ONLY HEIRS OF WILLIAM HAFHEY, DECEASED.
