RIGHTS HEREUNDER SHALL REVERT TO THE OWNER OF THE FEE AS SOON AS THE SAID USE
THEREOF SHALL BE ABANDONED, AND DISCONTINUED, OR THE SAID REPAIR AND MAINTENANCE
THEREOF SHALL CEASE.

THE PARTIES OF THE FIRST PART SHALL HAVE THE RIGHT TO THE USE OF SAID TRAIL, AND THE GRANT MADE BY THIS INDENTURE SHALL NOT BE TAKEN OR DEEMED AS IN ANYWISE LIMITING OR RESTRICTING THE RIGHT OF THE SAID PARTIES OF THE FIRST PART FROM CONSTRUCTING, OPERATING AND MAINTAINING ROADS, CONDUITS, ELUMES, POWER LINES, OR OTHER DEVICES, OVER, UNDER, UPON OR ACROSS THE SAID EASEMENT; PROVIDED, HOWEVER, IF SAID TRAIL IS BLOCKED OR PASSAGEWAY DISTURBED BY SUCH DEVICES, THE PARTIES OF THE FIRST PART WILL PROMPTLY RE-CONNECT AND MAKE SUCH PORTION OF SAID TRAIL PASSABLE; AND IF SAID PARTIES OF THE FIRST PART CONSTRUCT ANY FENCE CROSSING SAID TRAIL THEY SHALL PROVIDE OPENINGS AT SUCH CROSSINGS.

THE PARTY OF THE SECOND PART SHALL, AT ALL REASONABLE TIMES, HAVE THE RIGHT TO ENTER FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONSTRUCTING OR REPAIRING SAID RIGHT OF WAY, DOING AS LITTLE DAMAGE AS POSSIBLE.

WHEREVER THE WORDS "PARTIES OF THE FIRST PART" OR "PARTY OF THE SECOND PART" ARE USED, THEY SHALL INCLUDE THEIR HEIRS, EXECUTORS, ADMINISTRATORS OR ASSIGNS.
