The West half of the East half of the Northwest quarter (W. 1/2 of E. 1/2 of N.W. 1/4) Of Section Three (3), in Township One (1) North, of Range Five (5) East, of Willamette Meridian, containing Forty (40) acres.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said premises, with all their appurtenances, unto the said party of the second part, and to his heirs and assigns forever; and the said Bartholomew Bennett, party of the first part, for himself and for his heirs, executors and administrators, does hereby covenant to and with the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns, that he is the owner in fee simple of said premises, and that they are free from all encumbrances and that he will warrant and defend the title thereto against all lawful claims whatsoever.
