NOTES NUMBERED ONE TO SIX INCLUSIVE BEAR INTEREST AT THE RATE OF SEVEN PER CENT PER ANNUM, NOTES NUMBERED SEVEN TO THIRTY BEAR INTEREST AT THE RATE OF SEVEN PER CENT PER ANNUM FROM DATE TO JANUARY 1, 1928, NINE PER CENT FROM JANUARY 1, 1928 TO JANUARY 1, 1929 AT TWELVE PER CENT THEREAFTER.

SAID PARTY OF THE FIRST PART COVENANTS AND AGREES TO IMMEDIATELY PURCHASE ALL PIPES NECESSARY AND TO LAY, CONSTRUCT, COVER AND MAINTAIN A PIPE LINE FROM THE SPRING ABOVE MENTIONED ALONG THE ROUTE ABOVE DESCRIBED TO POINT OF TERMINATION AT INTERSECTION OF MCKINLEY STREET WITH ROCK CREEK ROAD AFORESAID AND THAT IMMEDIATELY UPON COMPLETION THEREOF HE WILL EXECUTE TO THE SAID PARTIES OF THE SECOND PART SUCH INSTRUMENT OR CONVEYANCE OF FURTHER INSURANCE WITH REFERENCE THERETO AS MAYBE BY THE SAID PARTIES OF THE SECOND PART CONSIDERED NECESSARY AND PROPER IN THE PREMISES.

SAID PARTY OF THE FIRST PART PROMISES AND AGREES THAT HE WILL DURING THE TERM OF THIS MORTGAGE KEEP THE SAID PIPE LINE AND ALL PREMISES HEREIN DESCRIBED IN PROPER REPAIR AND CONDITION AND KEEP THE SAID SPRING OR OTHER SOURCES OF WATER SUPPLY FREE FROM POLUTION AND CONTAMINATION.
