Wauna Lake Club to Portland Trust and Savings Bk.

This Indenture made as of the first day of May, 1931, by and between Wauna Lake Club, a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of Washington, party of the first part (hereinafter called the Mortgagor), and Portland Trust and Savings Bank, a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of Oregon, party of the second part (hereinafter called the Trustee), Witnesseth:

Whereas, said Wauna Lake Club, by its officers thereunto duly authorized, and pursuant to the powers and authority vested in said corporation is issuing its Seven Per Cent. First Mortgage Bonds numbered 1 to 450 both inclusive, 300 bonds thereof being for Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) each and 150 bonds being for One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) each, all of even date herewith and aggregating in face amount the principal sum of Thirty Thousand Dollars (\$30,000.00), all of which bonds are made payable to bearer, and the numbers of which, the denominations of each, the totals and maturities of which are as follows:
