This Indenture, Made this _____ day of January, in the year One Thousand Nine Hundred and thirty-one between Lester A. Burns and Blanche I. Burns, husband and wife, as mortgagors, and Gerald Goodsell of Portland, Oregon, as mortgagee,

Witnesseth, That the said mortgagors, for and in consideration of the sum of Twenty-three hundred and no/100 (\$2300.00) Dollars to them paid by the said mortgagee, do hereby GRANT, BARGAIN, SELL and CONVEY unto the said mortgagee and assigns those certain premises situated in the County of Skamania and State of Washington and described as follows:

Northeast Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Thirty-two (32), township 2 North, range 5 East of Willamette Meridian.

Together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining.

To Have and To Hold the said premises with the appurtenances unto the said mortgagee and assigns forever.

This Conveyance is intended as a Mortgage to secure the payment of the sum of Twenty-three hundred and no/100 (\$2300.00) Dollars (\$2300.00) in accordance with the terms of a certain promissory note of which the following is substantially a copy, to-wit:

On the or before 5th day of January, One Thousand Nine Hundred and thirty-four without grace, for value received, in gold coin of the United States, I promise to pay to Gerald Goodsell or order at Portland, Oregon, the sum of Twenty-three Hundred (\$2300.00) Dollars, in Gold coin of the United States, with interest thereon from date until paid, at the rate of seven (7) per cent. per annum, said interest payable quarterly in like gold coin. And in case said interest, or any part thereof, is not paid within ten days after the same become due and payable, then the whole of said principal sum and interest shall forthwith become due and payable, at the election of the holder of this note. And in case suit or action is instituted to collect this note, or any portion thereof, I promise to pay in addition to the costs and disbursements provided by statute, such sum as the court shall adjudge reasonable as attorney's fees in said suit or action. And I further promise to pay, before they become delinquent each year, the taxes assessed in Washington upon this note, or the debt thereby represented, and upon the mortgage of every date herewith given to secure this note and the debt thereby secured.

That they are lawfully seized of said premises, and now have a valid and unincumbered fee simple title thereto, and that they will forever WARRANT and DEFEND the same against the claims and demands of all persons whomsoever.

That they will pay the said promissory note and all installments of interest thereon promptly as the same become due, according to the tenor of said note.
