

RESTRICTIONS SET FORTH AND CONTAINED IN DEEDS FROM E. H. PRINDLE AND F. C. PRINDLE TO MIKE KOSKA

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME, TOGETHER WITH ALL THE HEREDITAMENTS AND APPURTENANCES THEREUNTO BELONGING, OR IN ANYWISE APPERTAINING, TO THE SAID PARTY OF THE SECOND PART, HER HEIRS AND ASSIGNS FOREVER, AS HER SOLE AND SEPARATE PROPERTY; AND THE ABOVE NAMED GRANTORS PARTIES OF THE FIRST PART, FOR THEMSELVES AND THEIR HEIRS, EXECUTORS AND ADMINISTRATORS, DO COVENANT WITH THE SAID PARTY OF THE SECOND PART, HER HEIRS AND ASSIGNS, THAT THEY ARE WELL SEIZED IN FEE OF THE LANDS AND PREMISES AFORESAID, AND HAVE GOOD RIGHT TO SELL AND CONVEY THE SAME IN MANNER AND FORM AFORESAID; THAT THE SAME ARE FREE FROM ALL INCUMBRANCES WHATSOEVER AND THE ABOVE BARGAINED AND GRANTED LANDS AND PREMISES, IN THE QUIET AND PEACEFUL POSSESSION OF THE SAID PARTY OF THE SECOND PART, HER HEIRS AND ASSIGNS, AGAINST ALL PERSONS LAWFULLY CLAIMING, OR TO CLAIM THE WHOLE OR ANY PART THEREOF, THE SAID PARTIES OF THE FIRST PART WILL WARRANT AND DEFEND.
