(57) That certain tract or parcel of land situate, lying and being in said Walla Walla County, bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at a point 90 feet north of the north line of Third Street and 45 feet west of the center line of Main Street in the City of Waitsburg, running thence south 11 feet; thence west 105 feet; thence north 11 feet; thence east 105 feet to the place of beginning; subject to a party wall agreement recorded in Book 93 of Deeds, page 303.

(58) That certain tract or parcel of land situate, lying and being in said Walla Walla County, bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at the intersection of the south line of Preston Avenue in the City of Waitsburg, with the center line of section eleven (11), township nine (9) north, range thirty-seven (37) east, Willamette Meridian, in said Walla Walla County; running thence south  $0^{\circ}45'$  east along the center line of said section eleven (11), 5.53 chains; thence south  $89^{\circ}55'$  west 2.62 chains to a point distant 50 feet at right angles from the center line of the Washington & Columbia Railway Co.'s tracks; thence north  $16^{\circ}16'$  east, parallel with the center line of said railway tract to a point in the south line of said Preston Avenue; thence north  $89^{\circ}30'$  east 93 links to the place of beginning.

(59) That certain tract or parcel of land situate, lying and being in said Walla Walla County, bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at a point in the east and west center line of section thirty-four (34), township seven (7) north, range thirty-three (33) east, Willamette Meridian, in said Walla Walla County, 20 feet east of the center of said section; thence south and parallel with the north and south center line of said section 100 feet; thence east 25 feet; thence north 100 feet to said east and west center line; thence west along said center line 25 feet to the place of beginning.

(60) That certain tract or parcel of land situate, lying and being in said Walla Walla County, bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the westerly line of Sixth Street in the city of Walla Walla, in said Walla Walla County, said point being north  $30^{\circ}00'$  west 113.8 feet from the point of intersection of the northerly line of Rose Street and the westerly line of Sixth Street; thence north  $30^{\circ}00'$  west along the westerly line of Sixth Street 150.4 feet; thence north  $79^{\circ}07'$  west 317.51 feet to a point on the northerly extension of the easterly line of Seventh Street in said city of Walla Walla; thence south  $30^{\circ}00'$  east 368.18 feet more or less to the northerly line of said Rose Street; thence north  $60^{\circ}00'$  east along the northerly line of Rose Street 106 feet; thence north  $30^{\circ}00'$  west 113.8 feet; thence north  $60^{\circ}00'$  east 194 feet to the point of beginning; subject, however, to easements or rights-of-way for such mains, pipes and appurtenances used in connection with the operation of the gas plant on the adjacent premises as on February 8, 1929, were being maintained and used in or upon the premises in this paragraph described.
