Know All Men by these Presents, that Bank of Stevenson, a Washington corporation the party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of forty eight hundred and no/100 Dollars, lawful money of the United States of America, to it in hand paid by A. P. Gordon, Guardian of the Estate of Margaret St. Martin, incompetent the party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, does by these presents GRANT, BARCAIN, SELL, ASSIGN, TRANSFER and SET OVER unto the said party of the second part, a certain indenture of Mortgage bearing date the 12th day of May, A. D. 1928, made and executed by Henry F. Meyer and Elizabeth M. Meyer, husband and wife to Bank of Stevenson to secure the payment of Six Thousand and no/100 Dollars, with interest thereon at 7% per cent per annum from date until paid, and recorded in the office of the county Auditor of the county of Skamania State of Washington, in Book S of Mortgages, page 259 on the 15th day of May, A.
