THIS INDENTURE, MADE THIS 24TH DAY OF NOVEMBER A.D. 1922 BETWEEN J. F. SWEENEY SHERIFF OF THE COUNTY OF SKAMANIA STATE OF WASHINGTON, PARTY OF THE FIRST PART, AND MARY J. DUFFY OF THE COUNTY OF MULTNOMAH STATE OF OREGON PARTY OF THE SECOND PART, WITNESSETH;

THAT, WHEREAS, BY VIRTUE OF A SPECIAL EXECUTION ISSUED OUT OF AND UNDER THE SEAL OF THE SUPERIOR COURT OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON, HOLDING TERMS AT STEVENSON IN AND FOR SAID COUNTY, TESTED THE 27TH DAY OF OCTOBER A.D. 1921, UPON A JUDGMENT RECOVERED IN SAID COURT ON THE 20TH DAY OF OCTOBER A.D. 1921, IN FAVOR OF MARY J.
