Beginning at a point in the middle line of the White Salmon River 24 rods north of the south line of section thirty (30), township four (4) north, range eleven (11) east, Willamette Meridian, in said Klickitat County; thence east fifty (50) feet; thence north $16^{\circ}45'$ east 289 feet; thence north $34^{\circ}45'$ east 206 feet; thence north 136 feet; thence west to the middle line of the White Salmon River; thence down along the middle line of the White Salmon River to the point of beginning.
