EASEMENT AND RIGHT OF WAY IN GROSS OVER THE FOLLOWING TRACT, LOTS, PIECES, OR PARCELS
OF LAND, SITUATE, LYING AND BEING IN THE COUNTY OF SKAMANIA, STATE OF WASH. AND:
BOUNDED AND PARTICULARLY DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS:

N. E. 4 of S. E. 4 of Section 16, T. 9, N. , R. 5 E., W. M.

THE SAID RIGHT OF WAY HEREBY GRANTED IS FOR THE MAINTENANCE, AND FULL, FREE, AND QUIET USE AND ENJOYMENT BY THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA FOR ANY AND ALL PURPOSES BY THEM DESIRED OR DEEMED NECESSARY OR BENEFICIAL FOR OR IN CONNECTION WITH THE CONTROL, ADMINISTRATION, OR USE OF THE NATIONAL FORESTS OR THE RESOURCES THEREOF, AND, SO FAR AS MAY BE WITH THAT ENJOYMENT COMPATIBLE, BY THE GENERAL PUBLIC AS A PUBLIC HIGHWAY OF A CERTAIN ROAD OR WAY HERETOFORE FORMED, BEING 30 FEET IN WIDTH, AND TRAVERSING THE ABOVE DESCRIBED PREMISES ACCORDING TO THE FOLLOWING GENERAL COURSES AND DIRECTIONS, TO-WIT:

BEGINNING AT A POINT 585.5 FEET SOUTH OF THE ONE FOURTH CORNER BETWEEN SECTIONS IS AND I6, T. 9 N., R. 5 E., W.M.; THENCE S. 86° W. 343 FEET; THENCE S. 86° 30' W. 468 FEET; THENCE S. 87° 30' W. 535 FEET TO A POINT ON THE WEST LINE OF R. C. LANGE'S PROPERTY.

THE GRANTEE SHALL AT ALL REASONABLE TIMES HAVE THE RIGHT TO ENTER FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONSTRUCTING, REPAIRING, AND PATROLLING SAID RIGHT OF WAY, DOING AS LITTLE DAMAGE AS POSSIBLE.
