Lina Aalvik to Bank of Stevenson

This Indenture, Made this 1st day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and thirty four between Lina Aalvik, a widow party of the first part, and Bank of Stevenson, a Washington corporation party of the second part:

Witnesseth, That the said party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Eight Hundred and no/100 Dollars, lawful money of the United States, to her in hand paid by the said party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, does by these presents, GRANT, BARGAIN, SELL, CONVEY and WARRANT unto the said party of the second part, and to its successors and assigns, the following described tract or parcel of land, lying and being in the County of Skamania and State of Washington, and particularly bounded and described as follows, to-wit:

Lot 25 in Block 6 of the Town of Stevenson, according to the official plat thereof on file and of record in the office of the Auditor of Skamania County, Washington. Also all rentals, issues and profits from said property which may be collected by the party of the second part and applied hereon.

together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging.

This conveyance is intended as a Mortgage to secure the payment of Eight Hundred and no/100 Dollars, lawful money of the United States, together with interest thereon at the rate of eight per cent per annum from date until paid, according to the terms and conditions of one certain promissory note, bearing date March 1st, 1934, made by Lina Aalvik payable on or before three years after date to the order of Bank of Stevenson and these presents shall be void if such payment be made according to the terms and conditions thereof. But in case default be made in the payment of the principal or interest
