SECTION EIGHTEEN (18). THE WEST HALF OF THE NORTHEAST QUARTER (W2 NE4) AND THE NORTHWEST QUARTER of the Southeast quarter (NW4 SE4), reserving and excepting therefrom all oil and mineral rights, together with the right to enter into and upon said described property, or any part thereof, for the purpose of exploring for, prospecting, developing, constructing and operating oil wells, refineries, pipe lines, mines and tunnels, with the right to cross with said construction, or any part thereof, any of the above described land, with all necessary and convenient facilities, either above or below the surface of the ground, including the right to construct all buildings, and make all excavations, openings, ditches drains, railroads, wagon roads and other improvements upon said premises, which are, or may become, necessary or suitable for the opening and operating of oil wells, and mines, and the removal of the products thereof from said premises.

MERIDIAN, IN SKAMANIA COUNTY, WASHINGTON, (BELONGING TO THE STATE OF WASHINGTON), AND RUNNING THENCE ACROSS THE NORTHEAST QUARTER OF THE NORTHEAST QUARTER (NE 1 NE 1), of Section One (1), Township Two (2) North, Range Six (6) East of the Willamette MERIDIAN, AND THE WEST HALF (W_2^1) OF SECTION SIX (6), TOWNSHIP TWO (2) NORTH, RANGE SEVEN (7) LAST OF THE WILLAMETTE MERIDIAN , IN A GENERAL SOUTHEASTERLY DIRECTION, -THENCE A RIGHT-OF-WAY SIXTY (60) FEET IN WIDTH, BEING THIRTY (30) FEET ON EITHER SIDE OF THE CENTER LINE OF THE RAILROAD AS LOCATED AND LAID OUT OVER AND ACROSS THE NORTHWEST QUARTER (NW A) AND THE EAST HALF OF THE SOUTHWEST QUARTER (E SW A) OF SEC-TION SEVEN (7), TOWNSHIP TWO (2) NORTH, RANGE SEVEN (7) EAST OF THE WILLAMETTE MERIDIAN, THE NORTHEAST QUARTER OF THE NORTHWEST QUARTER (NE 1 NW 1), THE SOUTHWEST QUARTER OF THE NORTHEAST QUARTER (SW NE NE NAME NE WEST HALF OF THE SOUTHEAST QUARTER $(W_{\frac{1}{2}} SE_{\frac{1}{4}})$ of Section Eighteen (18), Township Two (2) North, Range Seven (7) EAST OF THE WILLAMETTE MERIDIAN.
